TENTATIVE SCHEDULE OF THE ALLOTMENT PROCESS –

B.Sc. NURSING (NRI QUOTA)

The activities related to the NRI Admission to B.Sc. Nursing course for the academic year 2023-24 in our college will be commencing on 05/06/2023. This allotment will be conducted to fill up the nine (9) seats of NRI Quota. Eligible candidates can register their details online through the website www.mbcn.edu.in from 05/06/2023 5.00pm to 15/06/2023, 5:00pm. After registration, candidates may enter their application number and password in the link provided in the above website to log in to their home page.

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Mar Baselios College of Nursing is a Christian minority educational institution established, maintained and administered by the Mar Baselios Medical Mission Association. The College of Nursing with an annual in-take of 60 students for B.Sc. Nursing was started in 2003. The college is recognised by the Indian Nursing Council (INC) as well as the Kerala Nursing and Midwifery Council and is affiliated to the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS).

ADMISSION TO B.Sc. NURSING COURSE ON NRI CATEGORY SEATS

Academic Year 2023-24 – Prospectus & Instructions to the Applicants

1. The Managements are entitled to fill up to 15% of the total seats as NRI category by admitting qualified students who are dependents of NRIs. On the basis of the representation received from the aspirants and the clarification sought for by the College under the approval of Admission Supervisory Committee, the following directives are issued.
2. Applications for admission to First Semester B.Sc. Nursing (Academic year 2023-24) in the NRI category seats at this college is being invited online on the basis of this prospectus.
3. **Seat Matrix of the B.Sc. Nursing Course**

4. **Duration of the Course:** The academic duration of the course shall be eight semesters.
5. **Commencement of the Course:** The date of commencement of the course and the last date of completion of admission process will be as per the instructions from Indian Nursing Council.
6. **Academic Eligibility:** As per Indian Nursing Council norms, the candidates should have passed +2 with 12 years of school-ship with 50% aggregate in Physics, Chemistry Biology and English.

As per norms of Kerala University of Health Science (KUHS) for admission for B.Sc. Nursing, the minimum educational requirements shall be the passing of Higher

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Secondary School Certificate Examination (12 years course), Or Senior School Certificate Examination (10+2) Or An equivalent with 12 years schooling from a recognized board or university with Science (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) and English with minimum of 50% aggregate marks.

Note: All applicants must have taken courses in Biology, Physics and Chemistry in addition to English in the High School Years (during their 10th, 11th and 12th).

They should have secured 75% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the Plus Two level.

Wherever alphabetical grades like A, B, C+, etc. are used by the school, appropriate equivalence in terms of percentage like 90%, 75% and 60% should be made available.

Only students from high schools accredited by the respective State or the country and as such approved by the Association of Indian Universities and Kerala University of Health Sciences will be eligible for admission and **Equivalency Certificate** to this effect shall be produced.

7. **Age Requirements:** Applicants should complete 17 years of age on or before 31st December 2022. The maximum age limit for admission shall be 35 years. No relaxation of age will be allowed.

8. **Eligibility for apply in NRI Category Seats:** According to the GO(MS) No.243/2014/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014, *“An Applicant who depends upon his/her Father / Mother / Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) / Husband / Wife / Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) of Father or Mother / Half Brother / Half Sister / Adopted Father or Adopted Mother who is working abroad”* will only be eligible to apply in the NRI category seats.

9. **Certificates/ documents required to established NRI status:**

- i. A candidate, who apply for the NRI seat should submit the Passport copy and Visa/ Green Card/ OCI Documents of their respective sponsors. The job of the sponsor should be mentioned in any of the documents.
- ii. In case, the employment of the sponsor is not mentioned in the above documents, the candidate has to produce the employment certificate of the sponsor attested by the Indian Embassy of the country where they work/ Consulate authorities.
- iii. Relationship Certificate to be issued by the Revenue Authorities to prove the relationship between the candidate & the NRI relative as per GO(MS)No.243/2014/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014. However, the relationship between the candidate and his/her father/ mother, which are recorded in the educational certificates, maintained in the usual course of transactions by the competent authorities, shall be accepted.

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- iv. The Candidate shall produce the sworn affidavit from the Sponsor in a stamp paper worth Rs. 200/-. The same shall also be notarized by the Notary Public, disclosing that the student is dependent of the sponsor and the all expenses i.e. tuition fee and special fee, of the candidate for the entire course period will be borne by the Sponsor (*find specimen format Annexure-I*).
- ❖ The visa of the sponsor should be valid till the closing date of admission in respect of Medical and Allied courses.
 - ❖ The relationship between the candidate and his/ her father/ mother, which are recorded in the educational certificates, maintained in the usual course of transactions by the consent authorities, shall be accepted.
 - ❖ **All the certificates/ documents required to establish NRI status shall be produced at the time of submission of application itself. The certificates/ documents produced later shall not be entertained under any circumstances.**

10. FEE STRUCTURE:

Note: Apart from the schedule of fees given above, the students will be required to pay the proportionate examination fee payable to the University from time to time. (Annexure III)

11. Scheme of Admission:

- i. Application notification release 05th June 2023
- ii. Online Application will be available on <http://mbcn.edu.in> from 05th June 2023, 5pm onwards.
- iii. The application fee of Rs.1000/- can be paid online.
- iv. The closing of registration is on 15th June 2023, 5pm.
- v. The applications should be filled carefully; furnishing the entire information called for.
- vi. After the final submission of application, applicants will receive a unique application number.

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vii. Self-attested, scanned copies of the following documents shall be uploaded along with the Application (The originals documents are to be submitted at the time of admission).

- a) Secondary School Leaving Certificate (S.S.L.C.) of student establishing that the student must have completed 17 years of age as on 31-12-2022.
- b) HSE or equivalent examination mark-sheet / pass certificate.
- c) Proof for NRI status (**Refr. No. 9 above**).
- d) A statement to show that the high school in which the student has studied has been accredited by the State/Country/University (**if applicable**).
- e) Equivalence Certificate from Association of Indian Universities (**if applicable**).
- f) Eligibility certificate from Kerala University of Health Sciences (**if applicable**).
- g) Course & Conduct Certificate
- h) Transfer Certificate
- i) Copy of Aadhar Card
- j) Passport size photo

12. There will be a Physical Verification of NRI Documents and Interview which is tentatively on **20th June 2023**. Publication of NRI rank list on the website will be on **26th July 2023**.

13. **Closing of admission:** Closing of admission will be as per the regulations of the University and the Regulatory Council. After closure of admissions, the seat, if vacated, cannot be filled up. Such seats will go vacant for the entire duration of the course.

14. **Cancellation of admission and refund/ adjustment of fees:** Those who leave the course after the closure of admissions will have to pay liquidated damages equivalent to the tuition fees for the remaining period of the course. Any complaints in this regard shall be subject to the legal and factual scrutiny and the decision of the ASC/FRC. The colleges shall return the Certificate and TC of these students, on execution of a bond (Annexure III) by the student along with any of his/her Parents, undertaking to pay the amount that may be ordered by the AFRC or the Court of Law.

15. All students who get selected should get themselves vaccinated against Hepatitis B and Covid -19 before admission. A certificate to the effect shall be produced at the time of admission or before commencement of the course.

16. Every student is required to adhere strictly to the Code of Conduct of the college.

17. **Ragging is strictly prohibited.** If it is found during the admission or any time thereafter that the applicant has indulged in ragging in the past, admission may be refused or the student shall be expelled from the institution. Whoever commits, participate in, abets or propagate ragging within or outside the institution shall be suspended from the institution with immediate effect and the Principal shall report the matter to the civil/police authorities.

According to the Kerala Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1998, 'ragging' means doing of any act by disorderly conduct to a student of an educational institution, which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raising apprehension or shame or embarrassment to that student and includes teasing or abusing or playing practical jokes or causing hurt to such students or asking a student to do any act or to perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course be willing to do. All Institutions will have to abide by the directives of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, Dated May 16, 2007 in SLP No.(s) 24295 of 2006 University of Kerala Vs Council, Principals', Colleges, Kerala &Ors [with SLP (C) No.24296-99/2004 & W.P.(Crl) No.173/2006 & SLP (C) No.14356/2005] and the recommendations approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on effective prevention of ragging in educational institutions. In case, the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging in the past or if it is noticed later that he/she has indulged in ragging, admission may be refused or he/she shall be expelled from the educational institution. It shall be the collective responsibility of the authority of the institution to see to it that effective steps for preventing ragging are taken. Anti-ragging committees and anti- ragging squads will have to be formed to take effective measures against ragging and they should adhere to the stipulations and effectively monitor and comply with the directives. Each of the students of the institution and his/her parents, or guardian are required to submit a combined undertaking at the time of registration/admission in prescribed format available in (Annexure-II) which is mandatory for registration/admission.

18. Without prejudice to the directions of the Nursing Councils/Government/University, the decision of Mar Baselios Medical Mission Association shall be final on all matters with regard to admission.
